



# Our Staying Safe Charter

## Article 19: The right to be safe.

- . Wear a mask
- . Make sure hand sanitiser is available at all times
- . Make sure the room is well ventilated
- . Make sure tissues are available
- . Make sure we have a lidded bin
- . Have antibacterial wipes available to clean surfaces.
- . Make sure children remain in year group bubbles

- . Always face the front
- . Stay a 2m distance from members of staff and children
- . Use hand sanitiser regularly to kill germs and prevent them from spreading
- . Use the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach for coughs and sneezes
- . Not sneeze directly at a person

## Article 24: The right to health care.

- . Contact parents if children are feeling unwell
- . Make sure pupils have the right equipment if they are feeling unwell e.g. access to toilet, bucket
- . Provide first aid if pupils have an accident
- . Follow Covid19 guidelines for those children showing symptoms

- . Tell an adult if they are feeling unwell

## Article 28 & 29 The right to an education.

- . Provide online assemblies
- . Listen and allow pupils to have a voice
- . Make sure lessons cover what pupils need to know/struggle with
- . Help those who struggle
- . Provide the correct equipment and resources for lessons
- . Ensure the classroom has interesting books

- . Listen to others sensibly
- . Put their hand up and take turns respectfully
- . Limit distractions
- . Be respectful to adults
- . Ask for help or ask questions if they are unsure
- . Respect their own and other peoples' property
- . Give 100% effort at all times

## Article 12: The right to a voice.

- . Encourage turn taking so everyone has an equal voice
- . Remind children to talk quietly
- . Reward pupils for appropriate behaviour

- . Not make fun of people who get things wrong
- . Will not make noises
- . Will listen to others speaking
