The successful candidates will be available to work Post 1 - 11.50am until 1.05pm and Post 2 - 11.55pm until 1.10pm, Monday to Friday during term time. The roles involve helping to care for the children and supervise lunch time activities.

Duties to include:

- Supervising the washing of hands and entry of the children into the dining hall
- Helping generally during the service of the meals
- Assisting pupils where necessary

- Actively encouraging pupils in safe, enjoyable games while they are in the playground
